



Statement of Principle

1. The Resource Center for Pregnancy and Personal Health is an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ through His Church. Therefore, The Resource Center will present the gospel of our Lord in word and deed to all clients as the Lord gives opportunity. All those who labor as The Resource board members, directors, and volunteers are expected to know Christ as their Savior and Lord.
2. The Resource Center will provide and make available to its clients accurate and complete information about abstinence, contraceptives, sexually transmitted diseases, prenatal development, abortion and post abortion syndrome.
3. The Resource Center is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust and providing promised information and services. The Resource Center denounces any form of deception in its corporate advertising and individual conversations with its clients.
4. The Resource Center is committed to assisting women to carry to term by providing emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women may face the future with hope and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
5. The Resource Center does not discriminate in providing services because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, or marital status of its clients.
6. The Resource Center does not recommend, provide, or refer for abortion or abortifacient.
7. The Resource Center offers assistance free of charge at all times.
8. The Resource Center is committed to creating awareness within the local community of the needs of pregnant women, and of the fact that abortion only compounds human need rather than resolving it.
9. The Resource Center does not recommend , provide, or refer single women for contraceptives. (Married women seeking contraceptive information should be urged to seek counsel, along with their husbands, from their pastor and physician.)
10. The Resource Center provides thorough information on all three alternatives to an unplanned pregnancy clearly providing the client with both the pros and cons of each choice.
11. The Resource Center is not biased toward adoption in relation to other life-saving alternatives. The Resource Center does not receive payment for referrals and will not enter into contractual agreement with an adoption agency.
12. Because The Resource Center is a Christian, life-affirming ministry we reject out of hand all prolife activities that involve physical violence of any kind.
